

Alex is a conductor, violinist, educator and writer. He is founder and artistic director of the Darwin Ensemble Chamber Orchestra, with whom he regularly appears as soloist. He is a violin tutor and conductor for the National Children's Orchestra of Great Britain (NCO) and also teaches violin and coaches chamber music at the Royal College of Music Junior Department. Alex's students have won scholarships to leading conservatoires, are prize winners in the UK and abroad and are members of the NCO and of the National Youth Orchestra of Great Britain. Alex contributes articles on violin teaching to ARCO and JESTA, magazines for the European String Teachers Association, and his reviews of music and education regularly appear in the Strad magazine. From 2010-2017 Alex was Head of Strings at Uppingham School. He is now Artistic Director (Music) at the King's High School in Warwick, a role which oversees music provision for children aged 3-18.
